The County population is 41,428 in an area of 255 square miles which features a rich history in agriculture, which has produced many orchards, wineries, and bountiful farm markets from the fertile soil. It is home to more state parks than any other county in Ohio, as well as the Ottawa County National Wildlife Refuge, the only national refuge in Ohio. The County is host to several state wildlife areas, including the world-famous Magee Marsh Wildlife Area, location of the Sportsman's Migratory Bird Center and one of the top bird-watching spots in North America. The Erie Ottawa International Airport, nestled just outside Port Clinton, is in the









EXPLORE THE GREAT OUTDOORS

Plan your vacation around the pleasures of the great outdoors in the Ottawa County vacationland. A yearly visit should be on your "bucket list" because there are more State Parks here than in any other county in Ohio. Birding, fishing, and boating top the list for recreational adventures, with camping, biking, hiking, and swimming right behind.

Catawba Island State Park

is located on N.W. Catawba Road. This day park offers a fishing pier, launch ramp, and picnic area with shelter. There is a reservable shelter house at both Catawba and South Bass Island for family or business events.

East Harbor State Park

boasts a beautiful sandy beach and 11+ miles of hiking trails. The park includes the largest campground in the Ohio State Park system. Picnic areas are conveniently located next to the beach and allow for memorable views of the lake and surrounding marshlands.

Marblehead Lighthouse State Park

is located on the tip of the Marblehead Peninsula. It's one of Lake Erie's best known and most photographed landmarks and is open for touring weekdays during the summer.



Middle Bass Island State Park & Marina

is one of Ohio's newest state parks and is located in the western basin of Lake Erie. It is a boater's paradise, offering a 190-slip marina.

Oak Point Park

on South Bass Island is a day use park located on the northwest tip of South Bass Island. A scenic picnic area, fishing access, and overnight docking facilities are available.

South Bass Island State Park

offers a family campground, two picnic shelters, picnic areas, launch ramp, fishing pier and a small stone beach area. South Bass Island is accessible by ferry from Port Clinton or Catawba Island for a day trip, or spend the night in the unique efficiency cottages available for rent.

Visit one of Ottawa County's State Parks, or visit them all for beautiful views, excellent birding opportunities, swimming, picnicking, or hiking! To make reservations for camping at our Ohio State Parks, call 1-866-644-6727. Another unique experience is Schedel Arboretum & Gardens. A 17-acre estate that hosts nearly 15,000

samples of annuals, perennial beds, an extensive Bonsai collection and much more. Each year the beauty and serenity of this treasure brings thousands to the estate on the banks of the Portage River in Elmore. Since 1991 the SA&G has proved to be an extraordinary experience for young and old alike. Visit <u>schedel-gardens.org</u> for a virtual "mini tour" of these unique grounds.



BIRDING AT ITS BEST

Bird watching is at its best right here in Ottawa County! With a key position along the shores of Lake Erie, the county lies within the flight path of numerous migrating ducks, hawks, shorebirds, and songbirds, and hosts a wide variety of resident birds such as Bald Eagle and Trumpeter Swan. From coastal and inland marshes, to unique forests and prairies on the Marblehead peninsula and Lake Erie islands, the region boasts several great birding spots and is recognized as one of the best places to see birds in North America.

The Only Place to be in Spring!

Bird watchers from around the world know that northwest Ohio is the only place to be in spring! Between Magee Marsh Wildlife Area and Ottawa National Wildlife Refuge, thousands of acres of lakeshore habitat are easily accessible to visitors in search of migrating spring birds. The world-famous Magee Marsh Boardwalk offers birders and photographers outstanding views of warblers, vireos, tanagers, and other songbirds, often at eye-level and mere inches away – an opportunity that's hard to find anywhere else!

Coinciding with this natural bird-passage through the region, Black Swamp Bird Observatory's ten-day festival, The Biggest Week In American Birding, occurs annually in May and has quickly become the largest birding festival in North America. Featuring lectures, guided walks, bus trips, art and photography workshops, The Biggest Week offers a little something for everyone and at every skill level.

Birding Year-round

While spring may be the most dazzling time of year, each season presents new birds and new opportunities. In summer, the area is alive with the sounds of breeding Yellow Warblers and Baltimore Orioles, and sees recently fledged Bald Eagles leaving the nest and beginning to explore the marsh skies. Fall welcomes back the migrant birds sought-after in spring; some in more subtle colors, some as bright as ever, but all slowly working their way south. By winter, an abundance of waterfowl have moved into the marshes and fields; some – like the Tundra Swan – here until spring winds carry them back north. Winter also brings arctic birds such as Snow Bunting

and the famed Snowy Owl.

Whether here for a day or a weeklong excursion, Ottawa County offers birders a wide variety of

opportunities to explore the region and see birds like nowhere else.

Magee Marsh Wildlife Area and other Ohio wildlife areas are open sunrise to sunset, with scheduled closures during the fall hunting season. The Sportsman's Migratory Bird Center located in Magee Marsh is open 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday, and 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturdays and Sundays from April to September, with extended Saturday hours until 5 p.m. during April and May.


Ottawa National Wildlife Refuge and its associated properties are open sunrise to sunset, with periodic closures during the fall hunting season. The refuge's Visitor Center is open daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. For more info go to https://www.fws.gov/refuge/ottawa/ A 7-mile Wildlife Drive, which weaves its way through the immense main refuge, is open seasonally and on specified dates.

Black Swamp Bird Observatory is located at the entrance of Magee Marsh Wildlife Area, with a gift/nature shop and window on wildlife. Black Swamp Bird Observatory's Annual Biggest Week in American Birding is scheduled for the beginning of May, during peak songbird migration. Visit www.bsbo.org for the most current information and hours.

Boating enthusiasts and anglers come here every year to enjoy one of the nation's best recreational playgrounds, with the lake at the center of it all. Visit the longest and most beautiful coastline in Ohio here in Ottawa County!

There are many public fishing piers and breakwalls providing easy shoreline access. Species most often caught from shore include yellow perch, smallmouth bass, freshwater drum, and channel catfish. Whether it's by the shore, on your own boat, or with a charter captain guiding you, you will find outstanding worldclass sport fishing on Lake Erie.

Boaters occupy over 15,000 docks at marinas that cater to most every boating need, and access to the lake is available at several key visitor points. Numerous launch ramps to Lake Erie are located throughout the County on Catawba Island, Marblehead Peninsula, Sandusky Bay, and at several private marine facilities. Many local marinas can also accommodate sailors with deep waters. Boaters should always consult official



marine charters before navigating Lake Erie waters, particularly around the islands. Pay



close attention to weather reports as conditions on the lake can change very quickly.

If you do not own a boat but wish to participate in the joy of water sports, Ottawa County offers that opportunity, too. A sunset cruise around the beautiful islands can be the perfect beginning to a romantic vacation. Charter your own personal skipper to navigate the waters to your favorite

A RETREAT FOR PRESIDENTS...

Ottawa County History

Ottawa County was formed March 6, 1840, and was named for the Indian word meaning "trader" based on the trading of furs and skins between the Ottawa Tribe and the settlers.

The fleet of Commodore Oliver Hazard Perry was "put in" near South Bass Island before defeating the British in the Battle of Lake Erie during the War of 1812. The site now called Put-in-Bay was derived from this event. Perry's

ship, the Niagara, flew a banner with the words "Don't Give Up The Ship." Perry's victory was celebrated throughout the United States. It was the only surrender of the British Fleet in history, which helped prevent a western

invasion of the United States.

Middle and North Bass Islands were settled by Germans who found the lands suitable for growing grapes and making wine. Notably, Middle Bass Island was once a retreat for four Presidents: Cleveland, Hayes, Harrison, and Taft. Built in 1821, the Marblehead Lighthouse—the oldest lighthouse in Ohio— was

originally called the Sandusky Bay Light. This noted lighthouse stands at the end of the Marblehead Peninsula, which has been the roughest point on Lake Erie since the beginning of navigation on the Great Lakes.

Between April 1862 and September 1865, Johnson's Island served as a military prison, primarily for Confederate officers. No buildings remain, but the Island is the site of the prison cemetery. Port Clinton is home to the Ottawa County Courthouse, a site on the National Register of Historic Places. With its exterior made of Ohio sandstone, each side of the front entranceway has a carving of an Ottawa Indian. The tall bell tower's clock still sounds the time and is visible from all directions. Inside the Courthouse are mosaic floors, marble wainscoting and a pink marble staircase, plus murals depicting the County's history, including a two-story mural of one of Perry's victories during the War of 1812.

The Village of Oak Harbor, previously known as Hartford, was founded in 1835. Sawmills and various lumber-related industries were built here to clear timbers around the Village. Portage River

traffic moved products to Lake Erie and on to national and world ports. The name Oak Harbor reflects the prominence of the wood in the surrounding area and the importance of the Portage River to the Village.

The Village of Genoa is tucked in the most Western part of Ottawa

County. Genoa is a community

COMPETITIVE MARKSMEN ON TARGET

National Rifle and Pistol Matches Offer High-level Competition

Each year, thousands of the finest marksmen in the United States - plus a few from Australia, Europe and South America - converge on Camp Perry, an Ohio National Guard training site just six miles west of Port Clinton.

They come to compete for top honors in pistol, smallbore rifle, highpower rifle, and vintage military rifle competitions.

These matches draw more than 6,000 competitors, support staff, and volunteers to the training site, which is also programs headquarters for the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP).

Considered by many to be the "World Series" of competitive shooting in the U.S., the National Matches have been held at Camp Perry each summer for more than 100 years. The matches include the CMP's National Trophy Rifle and National Trophy Pistol matches and include the National Rifle Assocation's Pistol Championships.

Marksmen make their annual pilgramages to Camp Perry in hopes of shooting well enough to earn awards such

as the Distinguished Shooter's Badge and President's 100 honor, or a national trophy. The mission of the CMP is to promote firearms safety and marksmanship training, with an emphasis on youth.

The Camp Perry firing range complex consists of the longest rifle firing line in the world, running approximately 3,400 feet along the Lake Erie shoreline. Four different firing ranges have distances as long as 1,000 yards and cover 240 acres of the camp's total of 603 acres.

The CMP invites you to experience the Gary Anderson CMP Competition Center for air pistol and air rifle, with 80 firing points. It is open to the public on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 5 to 8 p.m.

Government

During the last two decades, Ottawa County has undergone many positive changes. Seven villages, twelve townships, and one municipality have developed a positive attitude of cooperative governing. This has helped spur tourism, industry retention, and growth in this area of Ohio's heartland, and has made it a popular and desirable recreation area for visitors from all across the United States.

The day-to-day operations of Ottawa County government are handled by three County Commissioners elected to four year terms. The City of Port Clinton (population 6,094), the County Seat, uses a statutory form of government. The mayor and seven council persons are elected to four year terms.

Madison Street's courthouse, in the center of Port Clinton, houses the majority of the County's offices. The beautiful historic Ottawa County Courthouse attracts visitors who enjoy its architecture and historic murals. Adjacent to the courthouse is the Ottawa County Detention Facility. A County/City government complex is on the east end of Port Clinton which houses all City offices, the County Health Department, and the Ottawa County Municipal Court.

Economic Development in the County is primarily guided by the Ottawa County Improvement Corporation. Ottawa County has a great working relationship with our regional partners, and is able to help meet your business needs. We are proud to be located in a region, state, and metropolitan area that have consistently won Governor's Cup Awards from Site Selection Magazine. With a business-friendly tax climate, available grant funding, real property incentives, workforce training assistance, and more, your business will thrive in Ottawa County.

Many healthcare needs are served through Magruder Hospital, a Port Clinton mainstay since 1940.

Magruder Hospital was founded by Howard B. Magruder along the shores of Lake Erie's North Coast in Port Clinton. Today, it continues to honor him by serving Ottawa County's year 'round population and seasonal tourists with a variety of inpatient and outpatient services. From its emergency, imaging, surgical, and laboratory departments to cardiac rehabilitation, cardiology, oncology, orthopedics, physical therapy, primary care medicine, and wellness programs, Magruder continues to expand its services and technology to meet the health needs of its community.

Medical services are also provided to Ottawa County by Promedica-Bay Park & Memorial Hospitals, NOMS (Northern Ohio Medical Specialists), Firelands Regional Medical Center, Mercy Health Systems, and FASTrack Urgent Care.







An Arts Community and More!

At the easternmost tip of the Marblehead Peninsula, surrounded on three sides by Lake Erie, lies the quaint Village of Marblehead. Home to about 900 year 'round residents, the area is host to thousands of visitors every year. The business district has a variety of specialty shops from art galleries and gift shops, to restaurants and ice cream shops. Several nationally known artists live here and have galleries and working studios in Marblehead, including Cary Ferguson, Bailey VanKirk and Rick Dziak.

Marblehead is a pleasant community for work and play, with strong family and community traditions such as the Halupki Festival, Lighthouse Festival, and the Perch Festival, along the many other community-minded fundraising events. This area is also home to the Marblehead Lighthouse and Museum, The Wolcott House, the largest stone quarry in Ohio, Lakeside Chautauqua, Johnson's Island, two state parks, two state boat launches, Lake Point Park, James Park, the rare Lakeside Daisy, and a battle site from the War of 1812. The ferry boat to Kelleys Island docks downtown.

Historically Speaking...

The beautiful 85 foot high Marblehead Lighthouse is the oldest continuously operating lighthouse on the Great Lakes. Commissioned in 1821, visitors today can climb the 77 steps to the upper deck and view Kelleys Island, Cedar Point, and the Sandusky skyline, as well as the Marblehead Peninsula. The lighthouse and the surrounding 14 acres are now known as the Marblehead Lighthouse State Park.

Lighthouse State Park

The Keeper's House is the original home of Benajah and Rachel Wolcott, the first lighthouse keeper. The Ottawa County Historical Society has restored the house, and during the summer season the museum, operated by the Ottawa County Historical Society, is open to the public.

The Chautauqua Experience

Founded in 1873, Lakeside is a seasonally gated community on the north shore of the Marblehead Peninsula. Committed to excellence in programming, Lakeside offers the area's most impressive entertainment and educational programs throughout the summertime.

Civil War History

Shops, restaurants, and Victorian era cottages round out the Lakeside experience. Each fall, Lakeside and the

During the Civil War, Johnson's Island, now accessible by a causeway, was a military prisoner of war camp for Confederate officers. No buildings from that era remain, but the cemetery is open to visitors. One earthen fort and part of another are still intact.

BEAUTIFUL MARBLEHEAD

33 Miles of Shoreline

Area parks and boat launches afford free opportunities to boat, fish, swim, hike, camp, play disc golf, snowmobile, and picnic, with beautiful lake vistas always nearby.

The Lakeside Daisy Preserve is the site of the largest concentration of this rare plant in the United States. Blooming around Mother's Day, the plant is celebrated the second Saturday in May with the Lakeside Daisy Day Festival.

Meadowbrook Marsh Preserve

Located on East Bayshore Road, Danbury Township's 190-acre Meadowbrook Marsh Preserve includes recreational trails, picnic areas and an observation platform for wildlife viewing. The property contains a diverse mixture of habitats, and harbors a number of rare plant and animal species. In 2013, the Township partnered with Black Swamp Conservancy to expand the Preserve by 80 acres, including the biologically significant marsh for which the preserve is named. Danbury Township includes the Village of Marblehead, Johnson's Island, and Lakeside, as well as the rest of the Marblehead Peninsula. It is almost 18 square miles with 33 miles of shoreline. With a population of 3,869, it is also home to several thousand summer-only residents, two volunteer fire departments, two police forces, and many marinas, campgrounds, cottages, motels, inns, and RV parks.

Ottawa County was formed on March 6, 1840 with its earliest settlers the Ottawa Indians. Migrating from Canada, these native North Americans took advantage of the area's abundant wildlife. They lived and traveled along the banks of the Portage River.

As more settlers arrived, they started building log cabins with the area's abundant hardwoods, and in 1895 they discovered that the lime in the area could fill the openings between logs of their log cabins. Early inhabitants also built a school and opened a store. The area was called Stony Station and later it was renamed Genoa.

A glacier deposited an incredible and unique limestone ridge through this area containing heavy strata of pure Niagara Dolomite close to the earth's surface. Limestone underlies the Genoa area. The facilities for lime burning were unsurpassed and made the area famous for its lime deposits. Genoa was

the greatest lime shipping point of the former Lake Shore Railroad. The lime industry was one of the earliest industries to be developed in northwest Ohio.

Dolomitic limestone is produced today in Genoa by Graymont, LTD, which manufactures the primary raw material, a rock from the remains of coral animals and plants from the bottom of oceans. The dolomitic limestone in Genoa is considered to be one of the best deposits in the world for the production of lime products. Oil and gas were also an important industry to the area. In the carly 1900s, 324 wells were completed. The formation

important industry to the area. In the early 1900s, 334 wells were completed. The formation from which oil and gas was obtained is known as Trenton Limestone. The portion that contains oil and gas is called Dolomite.



Historic Buildings and Grotto

The Town Hall (1883), The Little Privy built for school children, and the 600 block of Main Street as well as parts of Washington Street, are all part of the National Register of Historic Places.

The GAR (Grand Army of the Republic) building, built in 1856 as a school house, was later used during and after the Civil War as a post. The building now being restored is one of seven original posts (out of 725 posts) used during and after the Civil War.

Veteran's Memorial Park provides a playground, shelter houses, and quarry swimming. Our Lady of Lourdes Grotto and Stations is a replica of the Grotto in Lourdes, France. It was built in 1933 and is made up of 14 Stations

of the Cross bronze reliefs imported from Italy.

Makers On Main is a beautiful boutique with hand made items by local makers. Genoa Jewelers offers unique collections and a goldsmith. The history of Oak Harbor, Ohio began in October, 1832 when Joseph Wardlow staked a claim and plotted a Village some ten miles inland from the mouth of the Portage River in Salem Township. The settlement was incorporated on October 12, 1835 as the Village of Hartford, and W. W. Wardlow became the first mayor.

But perhaps the most important figure in the development of Oak Harbor was Adolphus Kraemer. Kraemer brought his family to Hartford in 1838 after purchasing

the claim and went about improving his town. He opened a general store and built a saw mill, and by 1850 he was the wealthiest landowner in Salem Township. He would, until his death in 1885, be the driving force behind every improvement be it the building of a school, land or charitable donation, establishment of service, or influencing railroad locations.

Because there were three other Hartfords in Ohio, the post office requested a name change. After much discussion, Oak Harbor was chosen: "Oak" to emphasize the prominence of that wood in the surrounding area, and "Harbor" the importance of the river to the village. The name of the village itself was changed from Hartford to Oak Harbor on March 27, 1863, and Oak Harbor was incorporated April 17, 1871.

"The Biggest Little Town" is Very Accessible

The Village of Oak Harbor, currently with a population of 2,675, is located at the hub of the industrial Midwest. The village lies on the North bank of the Portage River in Northwest Ohio It is 25 miles southeast of Toledo: 80 miles south of Detroit Michigan: 120 miles north

Ohio. It is 25 miles southeast of Toledo; 80 miles south of Detroit, Michigan; 120 miles north of Columbus; and 90 miles west of Cleveland. Access to Lake Erie, via the Portage River, is 10 miles due east from the village. Like most small towns in northwest Ohio, much of the business and commerce of the area is related to agriculture. However, many manufacturing, commercial, and small businesses also call Oak Harbor home. Recreational opportunities abound as the area enjoys a Lake Erie shoreline, beaches, marinas, fishing, and a wildlife refuge.



The village merchants have a lot to offer as well. There are beauty shops, retail/specialty stores, a hardware store, service stations, car dealers, a grocery store, churches, laundromat, banks, twenty-four hour police protection and an emergency medical service. For dining out, the village offers both fast food restaurants and full service restaurants.

The Benton-Carroll-Salem School District, Home of the Oak Harbor Rockets, is centered in the Village of Oak Harbor and is an anchor of community life. The district has consistently performed in the top 10% of school districts in the state, and offers students and families world-class opportunities in academics, extracurricular activities, and the arts. Green Spaces with Amenities

Oak Harbor has three main parks. Veterans Memorial Park is located on Finke Road on the east side of town. The facilities at the park include four softball diamonds, two full size basketball courts and three half-basketball courts, sand volleyball courts, a sledding hill, a multitude of playground equipment, two open air shelter houses with full electric service and lighting, and two restroom facilities.

Adolphus Kraemer Park is located on Church Street near the Municipal Building and Post Office. The theme of this park reverts



back to the good old days of a public square where the former town hall stood. There is a reconstructed 1870's log cabin on the premises as well as picnic tables and benches so that you can sit and relax and enjoy some quiet time.

Flat Iron Park gets its name from its shape. Located at the west entrance of the village, it is bordered by Water, Main and Toussaint Streets. A gazebo built "by the community, for the community" in 1976 has served as a site for weddings, picnics, organization meetings, and the live nativity scene at Christmas. This park also has a well-known county landmark with a memorial to local veterans of World War I in 1919 and rededicated to all veterans of all conflicts in 1985.


About the Chamber, Events, and Festivals
